<p>When updating the Sprint in a PBI, its children (i.e. Tasks) are not updated. This behaviour is also different to the "Move to last Sprint" and "Move to product backlog" links in the "popup" window.</p> <p>My expected behaviour: When changing the Sprint of a PBI (through the normal issue edit form), the Sprint of all non-closed child Tasks should be updated as well.</p> <p>I did attach a patch file with a solution that works for me.</p> <p>Thanks for considering this patch.</p>

I did see an issue with the Issue#update_parent_attributes after_save filter when moving PBIs in the burndown list. It tries to update the child issues twice and the falling into the optimistic lock.

This new version 2 patch prevents this.

Another problem showed up: When there are closed Tasks and the PBI is moved, the PBI is saved twice and results in a stale object exception.
