### Input date of the 'scrum new form' are not rendered correctly

#### Description

The input date fields of the scrum new 'child' form are not rendered correctly.

The reason is that the datepicker javascript file is never called on the board page.

The calendar\_for tag should do that, but because it's never called on the main page the lib does not exist and when the calendar\_for is called from the ajax request it cannot use the *datepickerFallback* api and add a calendar icon. (does an error in the console)

A naive workaround would be to add a call to it by adding

```
<%= calendar_for('issue_start_date') %>
```

at the end of the **common/\_scrum\_footer.html.erb** file
