No way to reproduce it, I rejected unless I get more info to reproduce it. Quan, is still happening? Did you tried with Redmine 4.1 series?

I've tested again on 4.1 but no error message... all the steps you have commented are OK, but the error is similar to other errors when the plugin folder is not scrum... maybe it's an issue of Redmine 4.0.0 with the scrum plugin, please consider to test it with 4.1 and latest master scrum plugin (only available for Patreon supporters <a href="https://www.patreon.com/ociotec">https://www.patreon.com/ociotec</a>).

I had the same problem, using the exact same Redmine(4.0.0-stable), Ruby(2.5.3-p105) and Rails (5.2.2) versions and Scrum plugin (v0.20.0) version.

I did the installation process (untar to plugins/scrum directory, rake redmine:plugins:migrate) and all that went OK.

And had the exact same error occurring to me:

I managed to solve it by copying the entire Scrum::Setting class definition and pasting it inside the Scrum module in the lib/scrum/application\_helper\_patch.rb file.

Could not manage to get a require or require\_dependency call to solve this.

It seems to be working for now.

I know this issue is marked as rejected, but if someone else is still having the same issue (which seems to be some incompatibility with Redmine 4.0.x), this seems to be a solution to it.
